The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 11.12.2018 vide which a direction was issued to look into the representation dated 23.3.2017 seeking protection.

Reply is filed. As per the same, no prima facie case was found in favour of the petitioner and the enquiry was carried out for almost two months in compliance of the directions of this Court. It is further stated by the Superintendent of Police, Panipat in the said reply that in case there is any apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then the protection shall be provided without any delay.

In view of the detailed reply, the contempt petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned Superintendent of Police in case there is any further threat to her life.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
