This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.2 dated 5.1.2019 registered under Sections 324, 323, 451, 427, 326, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 1.4.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Relies upon the order dated 07.02.2019, counsel for the petitioner states that co-accused has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

Notice of motion for 06.05.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjeet Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice. A copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer

on 08.04.2019 and on his doing so, he be released on interim bail to its satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 Cr.P.C.”

Today counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Harpreet Singh has accepted these factual assertions and stated that he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 1.4.2019 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
