ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN J.

Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 7.8.2018 passed by the trial Court vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person and a further direction was issued to register an FIR under Section 174-A IPC as well as the summoning order dated 21.8.2017.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 28.3.2019, the petitioner put in appearance before the trial Court and the trial Court released him on interim bail and he has deposited the costs with the Legal Services Authority, Fatehgarh Sahib. Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that, in fact, it is the complainant who has spent the amount for the purpose of proclamation and procuring the service of the petitioner.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of and the order dated 7.8.2018 passed by the trial Court vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person, is made absolute. This will, however, be

subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be paid to the complainant before the next date of hearing, failing which this petition deemed to be dismissed.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
