The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.151 dated 20.08.2018, registered under Sections 366, 376 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Dhuri.

It is stated that petitioner Salma brought the prosecutrix to the railway station in a car for the purpose of getting married and seeking protection from the High Court. She was initially declared innocent but later on she was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation, nothing is to be recovered from her and she is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 28.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
