The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.1), as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Gurmail Singh has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Amit Bhatia, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Naraingarh, Ambala and apprised the Court that the statements of petitioners have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no threat to their married life. Respondents No.4 and 5 also

recorded their statements, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. Copy of the reply has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the present petition.

Hence, the petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
