Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who have solemnized their marriage against the wishes of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Pathankot, which is taken on record. Reply is accompanied with the statements of Ajay Kumar, Vishal Kumar and Minakshi. Ajay Kumar-respondent No.4 has made his statement dated 18.05.2019 (Annexure R-1/T) to the effect that neither he nor his family members have given any threat nor they have any link with Minakshi. Similarly, statements of petitioner-

Vishal Kumar and Minakshi have also been recorded and annexed with the reply as Annexures R-2/T and R-3/T, to the effect that they do not want any police protection as they have not received any threat from the private respondents.

In view of above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.

However, in case the petitioners have any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned police authority.
