On 27.03.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No.2 and 3, to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

List on 30.04.2019.

Meanwhile, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and find out the existence of alleged threat perception to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.2 shall also verify the antecedents of petitioners and residential address given by them and submit report on or before the date fixed.”

In compliance of the order passed by this Court, status report

by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar

City, has been filed along with statements of petitioners as well as statement of respondent No.4, which are taken on record. Respondent No.4 stated that he has now no relation with his daughter and she may live as per her wish. The petitioners have also stated that they do not need any police security.

In view of the aforesaid statements made, the present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
