This petition has been pending since 25.03.2019, with it first having come up for hearing on 28.03.2019.

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 0199 dated 24.12.2018, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 307/323/506/34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959, on the basis of a compromise stated to have been reached between the parties.

When the petition first came up for hearing, i.e. on 28.03.2019, a request for an adjournment was made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Thereafter, on 16.07.2019, 18.07.2019 and 31.07.2019, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

On the last date, i.e. 28.08.2019, the following order was passed by this Court:-

*“On 28.03.2019, the petition had been adjourned
on the request of learned counsel for the petitioners.*

Thereafter, on July 16, 2019 and July 18, 2019, none appeared for the petitioners. Similar was the position on July 31, 2019.

Today, yet another request for adjournment has been made on the ground that learned counsel for the petitioners is appearing in a case in which he is personally involved.

Adjourned to 06.09.2019.

It is made clear that if the learned counsel for the petitioners does not appear even on the next date of hearing, appropriate action shall be initiated by this Court.”

Today, even on 2nd call in the post-lunch session, none appears for the petitioners.

Obviously, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the petition.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
