Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code for issuance of directions to official respondents for registration of a case against the accused persons i.e. respondent Nos.7 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that he is an accused in FIR No.603 dated 12.11.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, Haryana and it is conceded that the contents of the representation dated 02.03.2019 (Annexure P-5) are not part and parcel of the pleadings as contained in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C i.e. CRM-M-No.62152-2018.

It is further conceded by learned counsel for the petitioner that during the course of hearing in bail application he made a statement that the amount is due and would be paid to the complainant. By way of representation, the petitioner is now setting up a case that the amount is disputed amount and is praying for registration of a case against the complainant in above said FIR No.603 dated 12.11.2018 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order passed in the bail petition, the accused (petitioner) has joined the investigation and submitted his version before the Police.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking the powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C and the petition is dismissed.
