Petitioner Rajwant Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Criminal Complaint No.Nact/625/15 of 2015, titled as “Mandeep Saini vs. Rajwant Singh” (Annexure P-3), instituted on 06.11.2015, pending in the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dera Bassi, District Mohali as well as summoning order dated 09.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dera Bassi, District Mohali.

On 12.8.2016, learned counsel for the petitioner had given up challenge to the quashing of the impugned criminal complaint and the prayer was confined for clubbing the complaint case with the proceedings

in case FIR No.19 dated 29.2.2016, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Kha, District Moga. This Court had issued notice of motion in this petition only to the limited extent of clubbing two cases.

Since by way of order dated **21st May, 2019** passed in Criminal Misc. No. M-44238 of 2016, titled “Mandeep Saini vs. State of Punjab and others”, the FIR No.19 dated 29.2.2016, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Isse Khan, District Moga, stands quashed, therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

The petition is dismissed as infructuous.
