GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although petitioner's brother namely Vijay Kumar was murdered by respondent No.4, but for the reasons best known to the police, chose to lodge FIR under Section 304-A IPC only. It has been submitted that although petitioner had submitted representation Annexure P-4, but no action has been taken thereupon.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), District Jalandhar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously and in case the substance of representation is

found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), District Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
