The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married on 25.03.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

On 29.03.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. He has apprised the Court that FIR No.33 dated 06.03.2019 under Sections 346 IPC registered at Police Station Gulha, initially against the unknown persons, on the statement of father-respondent No.4. In the said FIR, petitioner No.2 is now nominated as an accused with addition of offences under Sections 363 and 366 IPC on 10.03.2019. The respondents No.4 and 5 are present in Court, who are represented by their

counsel. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 have further apprised the Court that no threat was ever extended to the petitioners as alleged. A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-4) further reveals that the same is vague and without any particulars. The contents of the petition also lack necessary particulars and do not inspire any confidence. There is no specific source or mode of alleged threat given.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
