Grievance of the petitioners is that they have not been accorded the benefit of promotion as has been done in the case of counter parts in terms of judgment dated 27.11.1987, rendered by this Court, in CWP No.470 of 1983.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the record of the case reflects that petitioners joined their service on 20.12.1972 and 01.11.1975, respectively. Their current age may seemingly be around 65 and 62 years respectively.

By sheer efflux of time, the claim to seek promotion has been rendered infructuous as by now they would have superannuated from service.

Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move appropriate application, if any cause of action still survives.
