In the present writ petition, the claim which is being raised by the petitioner is for reimbursement of the medical bills incurred by the petitioner for the treatment of his wife to the tune of Rs.1,43,262/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said treatment was undertaken by the wife of the petitioner from 24.11.2017 till 03.01.2018 and the medical bills were submitted by the petitioner with the respondents immediately thereafter. Learned counsel states that even after the expiry of more than one year, no action has been taken by the respondents for reimbursement of the said medical bills. Learned counsel further states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representation dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-5), thereafter another representation on 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) and the latest representation submitted by the petitioner was on 30.01.2019

(Annexure P-8). Learned counsel states that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation dated 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representations, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
