Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.48 dated 30.6.2011, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar City, on the basis of compromise dated 18.8.2011 (Annexure P-2).

Despite service, no one has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 (complainant). The report of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, date 01.9.2018 already on record, which reveals that the complainant did not appear for recording his statement with regard to compromise. It is noticed in the order dated 26.7.2018 passed by this Court that despite various opportunities none had appeared to get the statement recorded in support of the compromise.

It is apparent that the solitary ground of compromise raised in the petition has failed.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
