The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 130 dated 26.04.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of the IPC (Sections 325 and 307 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

**“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted regular bail after registration of the FIR and later on, the police has added Sections 325 & 307 IPC on the basis of the opinion given by the doctor regarding injury No.1 sustained by Harun. It is further submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, injury No.1, which is a lacerated wound bone deep over the skull, is attributed to co-accused Tarif and in the incident, even the petitioners have suffered injuries. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that vide order dated 11.06.2018 passed in CRM-M-25567-2018, co-accused of the petitioners namely Smt. Hamidi and others have been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail.
Notice of motion for 20.09.2018.”**

Status report, by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh, has been filed in Court today. As per paragraph No. 5 of

the affidavit, during investigation conducted by ASI Khem Chand, verified by SHO/Inspector Ashok Kumar, proposed accused Tarif, Akbar, Ashma @ Ashmina, Maina and Sehnaj were not found involved in the present case.

Investigating Officer SI Ranbir Singh, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2018, have already joined investigation and they are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 09.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
