ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 9, dated 25.6.2018, under Sections 379-B/392/395/216-A/411 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others had snatched the bag containing ₹ 25 lakh from the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is 26 years of age and is in custody for over 5 months since his arrest on 21.10.2018. He also contends that similarly situated co-accused namely Ranjit Singh @ Geju and Sanjay Pal Singh @ Bhundi have been granted bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-45748-2018 and CRM-M-11754-2019 decided on 29.1.2019 and 20.3.2019 respectively. He also contends that only sum of ₹ 50,000/- has been recovered from the

petitioner while the recovery effected from the aforementioned co-accused was ₹1.5 lakh each.

Learned State counsel filed the custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner has undergone total sentence of 5 months and 12 days.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 26 years of age, he is in custody for over 5 months and the trial would likely to take some time, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
