The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.06 dated 28.03.2018, registered under Sections 372, 370, 498-A, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Women, Amritsar.

Perusal of the police record transpires that the recovery of some articles have been effected and those have been got identified from the complainant but the same has not been returned to her.

Heard. The serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner in the FIR. As such, finding no ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.

However, complainant, who is present in person before this court, states that she wants to keep the custody of her elder daughter Jasman preet Kaur, who is also present in person before this court.

Heard. The elder daughter of petitioner namely Jasmanpreet

Kaur will remain in the custody of her mother (complainant).

However, the recovered articles be returned to complainant
against proper receipt and identification.
