These two petitions have been filed by the same person. CRM-M-15998 of 2019 has been filed for quashing of order dated 08.10.2018 whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No.108 dated 26.06.2017 registered under Sections 323 and 324 IPC at P.S. Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar. CRM-M No.14482 of 2019 has been filed for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise effected

between the parties and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the offences are bailable and that the matter has now been compromised between the parties. He further states that the petitioner would surrender before the Court to record the statement and move an application for regular bail. However, the trial Court be directed to decide the same expeditiously.

Having regard to all the facts and circumstances of the case, I don't consider it to be in the interest of justice to let this case linger. In the circumstances, the order dated 08.10.2018 whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender is quashed. Let the parties appear before the Court on 22.05.2019 to record their statements. On that date the petitioner will also move an application for regular bail and the trial Court is directed to decide the same on the same day.

With these observations, the petition bearing CRM-M No.15998 of 2019 is allowed.
