Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 730 dated 14.09.2015, under Sections 420, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jind City, District Jind and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all his pleas before learned trial Court at appropriate stage(s).

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner would be at liberty to appear before learned trial Court through his counsel subject to the following conditions:

- (i) petitioner shall be represented through Counsel;*
- (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- (iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;*
- (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence, but in the presence of his Counsel;*

*(v) shall appear before learned trial Court as
and when required;*

*(vi) any other condition which the learned trial
Court may impose.*
