Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurinder, Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, submits that petitioner Sonu has been declared proclaimed offender on 02.02.2019 and in the light of the same, the present petition by proclaimed offender, prima facie, is not tenable.

At this stage, faced with the likely consequences, counsel for the petitioner has made a statement withdrawing the present petition, however, reserving the rights of the petitioner to first challenge the order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender and, thereafter, approach this Court afresh on same very grounds.
