This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 153 dated 28.2.2019 registered under Sections 384 and 506 IPC at PS Sadar Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that on similar allegations FIR (Annexure P-3) was earlier registered in which the petitioner was arrested and released on bail. Thereafter, on same allegations fresh FIR has been lodged against the petitioner.

Learned AAG has accepted these facts but states that the petitioner is accused of extorting money from poor people.

In view of these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of conditional bail. Resultantly, the petition is

allowed subject to the condition that the petitioner would mark his presence every day till the filing of final report to the concerned police station in the evening at 7:00 pm and in the event of arrest he will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
