This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 120 dated 19.10.2017 under Sections 379B IPC of 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are regularly appearing before the trial Court and they have never misused the concession of bail. He further states that only on one occasion i.e. on 28.2.2019 they could not appear because of wrongly noted down the date as 28.3.2019 and now the Trial Court had issued non-bailable warrants against them.

In my opinion, in case above statement is correct, then one lapse can be condoned.

In the circumstances, let the petitioners appear before the Court on 8.4.2019 that is the date fixed in the Trial Court and if it is correct that they have never misused the concession of bail the Court would release them on bail to its satisfaction on that date.

The petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
