The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 12.09.2018, vide which, direction was issued to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to decide the representations dated 05.10.2015, 08.02.2018, 15.02.2018, 30.04.2018 and 30.04.2018 (Annexures P-1, P-3, P-7, P-9 and P-10 respectively) of the petitioner.

Reply on behalf of the respondent is already on record. As per the said reply, FIR No.19 dated 13.02.2018 registered against the side of the petitioner at Police Station Mehtiana was investigated as well as the DDR No.20 dated 21.02.2018, which was a cross case registered on the basis of statement made by the side of the petitioner. After investigation, challan has been filed in FIR No.19 of 2018 as well as in the cross case registered DDR No.20 on the basis of a complaint filed by the side of the petitioner. It is further stated that the accused in the DDR No.20 have also been arrested and after preparation of the separate challan in both the cases, the same were presented before the trial Court.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law.
