Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 08.06.2017, registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Section 326 of the IPC added later on.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first petition for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner has been dismissed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, vide a detailed order dated 22.09.2017, holding that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required. No material change in circumstances has been shown to this Court for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Nothing has been shown as to how the petitioner is now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above facts, I find that the petitioner is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
