Petitioners are aggrieved against the on-line transfer order (Annexure P-2), which has been uploaded on the website.

Learned State counsel has referred to the On-line Transfer Policy, 2018 (Annexure P-1). As per Rule 8, which relates to procedure to be adopted, willingness for transfer has to be given by the employees themselves. The employees have to send their preferences of stations where they had not remained posted for 05 years in the past. She states that once, the petitioner has given his option, transfer order has been passed as per the said option. As per Rule 8 (vii) of the Transfer Policy, within 10 days of issuance of orders, the employees aggrieved with the transfer process, can represent to the department after joining at the new place of posting, subject to fulfillment of condition mentioned in Para 6 of the said policy.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to

withdraw this petition with liberty to make representation in accordance with On-line Transfer Policy, 2018.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
