FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner husband Pardeep in this first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0410 dated 22.05.2018 registered at Police Station City Sonipat under Sections 323, 34, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC have been levelled by the complainant wife Shaveta alleging that she was married to the petitioner and as a consequence of taunts, demand of dowry/cash, harassment, cruelty and usurping her Stridhan, present case was got registered.

At the very onset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have already resolved their dispute and has placed reliance on the settlement agreement dated 17.12.2018 arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court,

submitting that since the matter stands resolved, nothing needs to be done further therein in the investigations.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI (Ms.) Saroj, Police Station Women, Sonipat does not dispute the fact so placed before this Court by learned counsel for the petitioner, together with the fact that vide orders dated 27.08.2018 this Court had earlier stayed arrest of the petitioner.

In the light of what has been canvassed before this Court, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
