The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 7.9.2018, vide which, direction was issued to consider and finalize the claim of the petitioner with regard to promotion by passing a speaking order.

Learned State counsel has placed on record order dated 19.4.2019, vide which, the claim of the petitioner was considered and benefits have also been granted to him. It is further stated in the said order that arrears of pay and allowances shall be drawn against the post of Accountant and shall be reimbursed to the petitioner as early as possible.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, the respondents are directed to release the said consequential benefits to the petitioner within six weeks from today. In case, the needful is not done, the petitioner will be at liberty to file fresh

contempt petition. Further, the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail the remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
