This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 2.6.2017 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC, 1860 and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act and offence under Section 472/120-B IPC added later on at police station Kiratpur Sahib, District Roopnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 1 year and 9 months. On the last date the matter was adjourned only for the cross-examination of the complainant and eye witness and those cross-examinations stand concluded.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh has accepted that as per the affidavit dated 15.2.2019 filed by the DSP, Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar it had been mentioned that the petitioner was arrested on 29.6.2017 and has been in custody since then.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
