The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 66, dated 25.01.2019, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Hansi, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 9.30 grams of heroin was recovered from his pocket which is less than the threshold of commercial quantity of 250 grams. He also contends that the petitioner is in his early twenties and a student.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kumar states that the investigation has been completed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is a student, investigation has been completed

and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
