This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 17.04.2018 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

Custody certificate dated 11.04.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon), Haryana on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 17.04.2018.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dhan Singh along with counsel for the complainant have argued that out of 18 witnesses, 15 witnesses have been examined and the matter is now fixed for 24.04.2019 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned State counsel, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence within one month from today (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms but it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on 13.05.2019, in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
