ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 101, dated 7.7.2016, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, Ludhiana District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he had pledged the documents pertaining to land which was owned by the complainant for obtaining loan from the Bank. He, however, contends that the matter has now been compromised and the copy of compromise is appended as Annexure P-2. He also contends that the amount of loan obtained by the petitioner has been returned to the Bank and the petitioner is in custody for over 2 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Pritam Masih, states that he is not in a position to controvert the statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner. He has filed the custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 2 months and 13 days.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 2 months, the matter has been compromised and the petitioner has returned the loan amount to the Bank, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
