On 30.10.2019 arguments were heard at some length, however, the case was adjourned on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Prayer in the present petition is to quash FIR No.179 dated 17.3.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. In the aforesaid FIR grievance of the respondent No.2 is with respect to dishonour of a cheque worth Rs.5 lacs.

After addressing arguments, counsel for the petitioner has come up with an offer that he would pay defaulted cheque amount i.e Rs.5 lacs. He has tendered a draft bearing No.000135 dated 4.11.2019 for an amount of Rs.5 lacs drawn in favour of respondent no.2 in Court today. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has accepted the draft and

submitted that he has no objection to quashing of the FIR in question.

Learned State counsel also does not have any objection.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2, however, submits that it may be clarified that such quashing of the present FIR would not have any adverse effect on other cases pending between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection thereto.

In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, present petition is allowed. Consequently, FIR No.179 dated 17.3.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
