Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 in FIR No.71 dated 20.05.2018 registered under Sections 365, 120-B of IPC with Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

State has already filed status report in the case by way of affidavit of Achhru Ram Sharma, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. As per para 4 of the report, during inquiry, neither any motive nor any finding for kidnapping the petitioner-complainant was found. She had gone with Bikram Singh to Hazoor Sahib at her own. She got the present FIR registered at the instance of her husband-Gurpreet Singh and his family members, as her husband had a grudge against Mohan Singh-respondent No.4, who is uncle of Bikram Singh. Therefore, the Superintendent of Police (Investigation) recommended to submit the cancellation report.

Para 5 of the report does indicate that cancellation report in the aforesaid FIR has been prepared and the same is being sent to the senior police officers for approval.

In view of the status report so submitted by the State, no action is required to be taken at the end of this Court and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in the event of submission of cancellation report, if the petitioner is still aggrieved, she is at liberty to avail the remedy of law as available to her.
