Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in FIR No.78 dated 09.06.2017 registered under Sections 346/363/376D (Sections 363/376 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Bicchor, District Nuh (Mewat).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, Police Station Bicchor, states that in the aforesaid FIR, accused-respondents No.5 to 7 and 10 are absconding and have been declared Proclaimed Offenders, whereas respondents No.8 and 9 i.e. Sheru (Sher Mohd.) son of Jasu and Husain (Mohd. Husain) son of Kamrudeen, respectively, have been found innocent.
