Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.27 dated 03.04.2017 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2)

In compliance to the order dated 06.10.2018, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patti has been received that the parties have entered into compromise so as to bring home peace and harmony which is without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the matter, continuation of proceedings before the trial Court is useless exercise. Accordingly, FIR No.27 dated 03.04.2017 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential

proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioner.
