The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.95 dated 14.4.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 12.7.2018, report dated 14.8.2018 (in connected case i.e. CRM-M-28631-2018) has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
