KULDIP SINGH, J.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has made the statement that since adequate compensation has been awarded to the respondent No. 1-J.K. Aneja, husband of Veena Aneja in **FAO-3382-2001, Veena Aneja & others vs. Raj Kumar and others**, he give up his claim in MACT case No 15 filed on 23.5.1997, which was decided along with the connected claim case No. 16 and against which Insurance Company has filed the present appeal.

Accordingly, present appeal is allowed and the amount of compensation as awarded by the Tribunal to the tune of Rs. 30,000/- to respondent No. 1 is set aside in view of the fact that J.K. Aneja, husband of Veena Aneja has been awarded adequate compensation in claim petition filed by Veena Aneja-injured now deceased i.e. **FAO-3382-2001, Veena Aneja & others vs. Raj Kumar and others**.
