The present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the due payment of ₹1,12,72,470/- qua the work of maintenance and upkeep of parts of telecom infrastructure in Amritsar SSA alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Counsel submits that a demand notice dated 19.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) has been served upon the respondents, which has been replied vide Annexure P-3 that payment would be made as soon as the funds are received from the Circle Office, Chandigarh.

Keeping in view the above and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner, directions are issued to respondent No.4 to examine the claim of the petitioner in the light of demand notice dated 19.02.2019 (Annexure P-2) and take a final decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

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Needless to observe that in case any outstanding amounts are found due, the necessary funds would be released to the petitioner without any further delay.
