Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana City submits that upon the complaint lodged by the petitioner, two FIRs bearing No.149 dated 23.09.2018 under Sections 177 IPC and Section 12(1)(b) of the Passport Act pertaining to Police Station City Hoshiarpur and No.75 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, have been registered and the State undertakes that the investigation in these FIRs shall be completed within this year only.

In the light of this stand of the State, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed off as such. However, the petitioner shall reserve her right to invoke jurisdiction of this Court on the same very grounds afresh if so necessitated.
