DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail has been filed by petitioner-Deepak Kumar in case FIR No. 466 dated 30.9.2015 registered under Sections 192,201,307,419,120-B IPC and Sections 25,29 of Arms Act at Police Station Shahabad, during pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that main accused, namely, Anurag Sharma and Rajinder Singh have been released on regular bail. The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender and was arrested on 9.1.2018. Out of total 35 prosecution witnesses, 21 have been examined, trial may take some time to conclude and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

Learned counsel for respondent-State has not disputed the

custody period, stage of the trial as well as release of two co-accused including the main accused on regular bail.

Keeping in view the custody of the petitioner since 9.1.2018 and also the facts that two co-accused of the petitioner including the main accused have been released on regular bail; material witnesses have been examined; trial may take some time to conclude and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Deepak Kumar is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
