The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.32131 of 2018

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

*“Petition is hereby disposed of. In case petitioner sends a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of this order by registered/speed post, the authority shall pass a speaking order at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks of receipt thereof. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same be released after sanction from the Finance Department, if required.*

Learned State counsel submits that one last opportunity be granted to comply with the order dated 15.12.2018. He assures that needful shall be done within eight weeks from today.

At this stage, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to do the needful within eight weeks from today.

In case of failure to comply with the order, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition which shall be at the cost and responsibility of the defaulting official.
