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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 86 dated 27.03.2018 registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, for the offence under Sections 379 IPC.

Vide dated 12.07.2018, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Moreover, the motorcycle, allegedly stolen, has already been recovered from the co-accused of the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 12.07.2018, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
