Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they have solemnized marriage on 26.03.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

On 02.04.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the statements of petitioners and respondent Nos.4 to 6 have been recorded and same have been filed in the Court which are taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the statement of petitioners, it is revealed that they have no threat as on today and they are happily residing, whereas in the statements of respondent Nos.4 to 6 revealed that they have no objection to the alleged marriage. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition.
