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On the last date of hearing, it was stated by representatives of the departments as well as by learned AAG, Punjab, for respondent Nos.3 to 5 that pay scale as demanded by the petitioner in this case was already granted to him and after receiving entire payment, he had sought premature retirement in the year 2001 and that nothing remains due to the petitioner at present. However, as nobody appeared for the petitioner on the last date of hearing, the case was adjourned for today for the presence of the petitioner. It may also mention here that copy of requisite order was also placed on the record on behalf of respondent Nos.3 to 5. Even on the previous dates of hearing i.e. on 07.12.2018 and 20.02.2018, none had appeared for the petitioner. Learned proxy counsel, who has appeared for the petitioner today, has stated that even arguing counsel for the petitioner is not in contact with the petitioner.

In view of these facts, we are of the view that the present petition might have become infructuous and that's why petitioner is not coming present nor contacting his counsel. In view of the same and in view of the statements of representatives of respondent Nos.3 to 5 and learned AAG, Punjab, the present writ petition is ordered to be consigned to the record room with liberty to the petitioner to get it revived, if so desire.
