Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition had been filed basically on account of matrimonial discord between the petitioner, his daughter and his wife-respondent No.6, which has now been amicably resolved and that a petition under Sections 11 and 12 of Hindu Marriage Act is presently pending before the Family Courts at Gurdaspur and is to be taken up before the Lok Adalat tomorrow. It has thus been

submitted that in pursuance of the compromise, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the main case.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the main case i.e. CRM-M-27797-2017, which is fixed for 23.3.2020 is preponed and is taken on board today.
