The petitioner has been ordered to be evicted from 6 marlas of land comprising a portion of the total land comprised in Khasra No.46, Khewat No.325, Khatauni No.488 situated in the revenue estate of village Sadhu Chak, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur, being the encroachment of *Sare aam rasta* (Public Passage) by the Collector on an application moved by the Gram Panchayat under Section 7 of Punjab Village Common Land (Regulations) Act, 1961, vide order dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure P-7). The order dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure P-7) has been upheld and the finding affirmed by the Appellate order dated 12.10.2018 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Director Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab (Exercising the powers of Commissioner). The findings are based on the demarcation report dated 16.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) conducted by the Tehsildar in the presence of, *inter alia*, sons of the petitioner. Concededly, no objections were filed by the petitioner against the said demarcation report.

In the instant petition, the challenge is to the aforesaid orders dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure P-7) and 12.10.2018 (Annexure P-9) respectively.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner prays
for unconditional withdrawal of this writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
