This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.21 dated 11.02.2019 registered under Sections 147/148/149/323/341/506/336/307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Maloya, District Chandigarh.

Custody certificate dated 04.04.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Amandeep Singh, CPS, Deputy Superintendent, Model Jail, Chandigarh on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone 01

Counsel for the petitioner states that the similarly situated co-accused has been granted concession of regular bail by this Court passed in ***CRM-M-12459 of 2019 vide order dated 26.03.2019*** after he had undergone 01 month and 04 days of actual custody whereas the present petitioner had undergone more than that.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ashwani Kumar has accepted this fact. He has also fairly accepted that the case of the petitioner is similar to that of co-accused Amandeep who has been granted bail by that order.

In my considered opinion, keeping in view the nature of allegations made against the petitioner and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
