This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.21 dated 11.02.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 506, 336, 307 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Maloya, District Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that similarly situated co-accused Amandeep was granted the concession of bail by this Court by order dated 26.03.2019 passed in CRM-M-12459-2019 and another similarly situated co-accused was granted the concession of bail by order dated 05.04.2019 passed in CRM-M-14694-2019.

Learned Addl.P.P. for U.T. Chandigarh has accepted these
facdtual assertions.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 08.04.2019 by Amandeep Singh, CPS, Deputy Superintendent, Model Jail, Chandigarh is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 01 month 14 days of custody.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/CJM/trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
