By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the private respondents had executed an agreement for sale of land in favour of the petitioner but since the private respondents did not honour the agreement, the petitioner was constrained to approach the civil Court to file a civil suit seeking specific performance of the agreement. It has been submitted that the private respondents, however, have been threatening and have been pressurizing the petitioner to withdraw the suit and have now submitted a false complaint (Annexure P-3) with the police and the police is

now harassing the petitioner by calling him to the police station time and again.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to ensure that the petitioner is not caused any harm. Further, in case the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or any information is required to be elicited from him, then a prior written notice be furnished to the petitioner before summoning him.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
